From our Principal....

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

On Tuesday our Year 6 students departed school with much excitement for their **annual camp at Lindisfarne**. School activities such as camps require significant planning from staff prior to the actual week in order to make the experience as rewarding as possible for all involved. We are also fortunate to have so many willing parents who provide transport, stay overnight and support staff across the week. This also applies to syndicate trips like the one that was planned for Year 3 -4 students to the Otipua Wetlands, which was affected by rain earlier in the week.

It was encouraging to see so many of our junior students achieve recognition for their creations at the **A and P Show** recently. Our Agrikids teams also did well in their competition, with "The Best Farmers" (Thomas Batty, Matthew O'Connor and Olly Adams) coming first and the "G Town Farmers" (Charlotte Orange, Phoebe Wilson and Isla Fisher) placing second. Congratulations to everyone involved. Bookings can now be made online for **3 Way Conferences**, which will take place on **Friday 24 March**. If you need assistance with this, please contact the school office and we will book an interview for you. Please note that bookings will close on Wednesday 22nd March and it is important that bookings are made by this day. Teachers will be involved in 3WCs all day on Friday 24 March and normal classes won't be taking place. Children will come to school for their 3WC only. There will be no school buses running on this day.

Each term the Board of Trustees review **policies** as part of a three year cycle. This term we are asking parents / whanau to assist us in this process by reviewing the Recognition of Cultural Diversity policy. Finally, our annual **Breakfast BBQ** will be held before school on Friday 7 April. It serves as a fundraiser for our sponsored child Htet Wai Yan Oo who lives in Myanmar. Our senior students always have a great time preparing for this event and it's a good way for our school community to come together, catch up and support a wide variety of stalls. More details will follow shortly.

The GPS Office accounting package is now being upgraded. Online payments are preferred but remember to include your child's name and reason for payment as the reference. We are excited to introduce to you Te kupu o te wiki, the word of the week


