From our Principal....

We are now into the last month of the school year and again it is a very busy time in our calendar. Teachers are writing **end of year reports**, which will be sent home on Wednesday 13th December. There have been comments in the media about the pending removal of National Standards from the Primary Education system as a result of a change in Government policy. While this will eventually happen, we have not yet received official notification from the Ministry of Education about the removal of National Standards. As such, all schools will be reporting against the standards for the time being.

We have been making ongoing modifications to how we **recognise positive behaviour** from our students. Initially this took the form of Gotcha tokens and this year we have introduced the postcards for students who have received 20, 40, 60 or 80 Gotchas. Some time ago we realised that some of our students will have accumulated 100 Gotchas this year and that we needed to recognise this milestone in a slightly different way. Today we awarded our first lot of students who have received 100 Gotchas special wrist bands. Congratulations to:

Ella, Dan, Georgia, Matthew, and Phoebe from Room 4 and Riley from Room 5. A wonderful achievement.

The Board of Trustees has recently reviewed **Activity Fees** for 2018 and there is a slight change in how this will be structured. An issue that many schools face is the difference between the running costs of the school and what we receive in funding from the Ministry of Education. We are therefore asking for a donation of \$15 per term / \$60 for the year per child. This donation will be used to purchase curriculum resources. Part of this amount can be claimed back through tax returns.

Alongside the donation we will be charging a \$5 Activity Fee per child per term / \$20 per year. This will pay for visiting performers that we book throughout the year. All other activities that incur a charge, e.g. Y6 camp, ice skating, skiing, syndicate visits, will be invoiced prior to the activity.

A group of staff and myself have been working towards the introduction of **House Groups** in 2018. This will see children placed in one of four houses, with siblings being placed together. All staff will also be allocated a house group. The house groups are: Whero (red), Kowhai (yellow), Kakariki (green), and Kahurangi (blue). House groups will be involved in different types of activities and it will enable children of different ages to come together for a common purpose. There will also be leadership opportunities for senior students within each house. Many parents will remember being part of a house group when they were at school and the types of activities that this involved. Our **school pool** will be open and ready for use from Tuesday 28th November. Classes will be swimming every day. Students will require named togs and towel. Please ensure that all other clothing is also named. Pool keys will be available for hire from the school office from Monday 4th December at a cost of \$60. All keys need to be returned at the end of the swimming season.

Our **Athletic Sports** are on at the Domain tomorrow. I wish all students the very best for their events. Parents and families are welcome to join us for the day. The programme for the Athletics was included with last week's flyer.
