From our Principal....

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Welcome back to the start of Term 3 everyone. It is wonderful to be back at Geraldine Primary after my sabbatical last term and seeing lots of familiar faces and quite a few new ones also. I trust everyone has had a safe and restful holiday and is ready for the term ahead.

If you have not already booked your 3 Way Conference, please do so by next Wednesday. Further details are below. Room 15 students will not need to attend a 3WC as Mrs Sullivan and Mrs Gardiner will be reporting to parents separately based on their child's first month at school. This will also apply to some Room 9 students.

As part of our ongoing school development, we have been considering the future technology needs of our students, with particular reference to those in Years 4-6. The New Zealand Curriculum specifically references the value of e-learning with digital fluency being a current Ministry of Education priority. We recognise the benefits that access to technology brings to our students with their learning, both now and in the future.

In order to continue to provide our students with the best learning opportunities, in 2018 we will be inviting and encouraging all Year 4 students (current Year 3's) to bring their own Chromebook to school on a daily basis, with the view to widening this for all Year 4 – 6 students in 2019. This will allow us to phase in this Bring Your Own Chromebook (BYOC) initiative gradually. Chromebooks are affordable and easy to use devices that are used in many schools and have proven to be effective in supporting learning both in the classroom and at home. The Chromebooks will be able to be brought to school and taken home each day and will be stored safely when not in use; for example at lunchtimes, assemblies etc..

A separate letter to the parents of all current Year 3 students will be sent home shortly and will provide details of a BYOC information afternoon that will be held at school. This will provide the opportunity to learn more about Chromebooks, purchasing options and

have any questions answered. This is an exciting opportunity for our school and we look forward to keeping you all posted with developments. If any parents have any queries, please feel free to make contact with either myself or Jo Drake.

Finally, best wishes to the Home & School and all the dancing couples who are performing at Dancing with the Stars next Saturday. Tickets have sold very quickly and I know it will be a wonderful evening with lots of entertainment.

In line with our new accounting system, we have now installed a locked blue dropbox in the office entry. While our preferred method of payment is by direct banking, parents who wish to pay cash or cheque can use this box to deposit payments.

Payments must be in an envelope clearly labelled with your child's name, room number and the purpose of the payment. Cash must be the correct amount as no change is able to be given. The dropbox will be cleared daily, and payments will be recorded in our online system. Receipts will be issued on request.

Reading folders and bus vests will still be sold from the school office and payment for this needs to be given direct to the office ladies. Please be aware that we do not have eftpos facilities and the correct payment amount would be much appreciated as the office does not carry change.

Please use your child's name as a reference and what the payment is for e.g. Activity Fee, Camp etc.


Mauri ora whānau,

Geraldine Primary Community Stock Scheme 2017

While we are all trying to keep dry and warm this winter, spring is not far away and once again we are asking our local farming community to support our school by rearing calves and lambs for our annual stock scheme. This fundraiser is one of the main cash earners for our school where 100% of the earnings are donated back to our school.

For those families new to the scheme, a heifer or bull calf, either dairy or beef, is selected early in the calving season, tagged with a tag provided by the Home and School, reared on farm alongside other stock and then collected early December for auction at the Temuka Sale Yards. All calves are weighed individually before sale. Lambs can be similarly donated for sale at weaning with all proceeds going to GPS.

Thank you to the families who have donated in the past. Your generosity is very much appreciated. The funds raised have been used to further our teaching resources available to our children, eg: upgrading the playground; purchasing robotic kits and computers for class use; upgrading the library furniture and improving the junior block to mention just a few.
