On Friday 16 March the Primary Teachers Union (NZEI) will be having meetings during the school day to discuss matters pertaining to their collective agreement. School will continue to be open on this day however there will be alternative programmes in place to allow staff to attend either a morning or an afternoon meeting. This will see children working in another class for part of the day. If parents wish to keep their child home on this day, they are welcome to do so.

Each term the Board of Trustees reviews policies as part of a three-year cycle. This term we are asking parents / whanau to assist us in this process by reviewing the **Home Learning policy**. A reminder to families that school commences at 8.50am. Children should arrive at school before this, so that they have time to get ready for the day ahead. Being on time and punctual is an important life skill as is getting to class on time at the start of the day and after a break.

We ask that children who are late to school for any reason report to the office before going to class. If your child is going to be away, please contact the school office and leave a message along with the reason for absence. We are required to know the

reason for absence, so the accurate Ministry of Education code can be used. If a reason isn't provided, the absence is classed as unjustified.

Some of you will be aware by now that we have been advertising for a new Office and Financial Administrator. Jane Paton has accepted a position in the office at Geraldine High School. We wish her all the very best in this new role. Her last day will be Wednesday 14 March.
