From our Principal

Welcome back to the start of Term 3. It has been a busy start for many people with Middle Syndicate trips to the Canterbury Museum in Christchurch and the Senior Syndicate at Tekapo today.

Through last term we had two teams competing in the EPro8 Challenge with one team, the GPS Magic progressing through the competition to reach the Canterbury finals. A big well done to Poppy S, Riley D-M, Hunter W, and Zoe K for their 3rd placing overall! This is a fantastic achievement in only our second year of competing. Throughout the competition the group worked particularly well together in an event where teamwork is key.

As posted on our school Facebook page earlier in the week, Primary Teachers and Principals have voted to strike for a full day on Wednesday 15 August. This is a result of the Union and the Ministry of Education not being able to reach an consensus over their Collective Agreements. The main issues nationwide are the recruitment and retention of staff to address the teacher shortage and better support for children with additional learning needs.

On the above date school will be closed. This means that children will be required to stay at home. While there have been two stop work meetings in recent times during the school day, this is the first time since 1994 that Primary Teachers and Principals have elected to take industrial action with regards to their collective agreement.

Tomorrow we will be having a Muffi Day in support of the Geraldine Children Social Work Trust. We encourage every child to bring a gold coin for this very worthy cause. There is no dress up theme for this day. The Social Work Trust supports local children and youth along with their families when it is required. We have a Family Support Worker based at Geraldine Primary who also works in other schools and early childhood centres. The Trust is funded through donations and grants. It is important to note that it does not receive any funding from the Ministry of Education. We are fortunate that we have the Trust operating in our community.

We are delighted to announce that Deana Averill, who many of you will know, will be returning as our Family Support Worker in the very near future. Deana has previously worked at Geraldine Primary in the same role.

Enviroschool

At Geraldine Primary School we are becoming an Enviroschool! We have been working on this journey since 2016 and are continuing to work on our sustainable practices. We have brought in bins that help the children and staff classify waste, we have begun an orchard by the hall, added some new sensory gardens by Room 9, started our Enviro mural and vision map of our journey, discussed our Maori perspective, looked at the principles of an Enviroschool, continued our vegetable gardens and worm farm, removed mixed waste bins from around the school and started a 'Green Team' who help with these activities and practices.

One change being made as part of this is the children's school lunches. We are asking that the children take home any food scraps and litter that is leftover from their lunch, so that parents are aware of what their children are eating and the waste that is left. The aim is that we reduce our waste for the future and continue to make sustainable choices.


