Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all. Welcome back to the start of Term 3 everyone. I trust that your children are ready and excited for the term ahead them.

You will have seen the Room 10 and 13 building work that has commenced over the holidays. Some good progress has been made on this project, with much still to occur. I would like to acknowledge the families and local businesses who have sponsored this project. We are still taking donations of any denomination; if you would like to make a donation, please contact the school office. We are currently making applications to Charitable Trusts to help us reach our goal.

We currently have the Life Education caravan onsite which will remain with us until the middle of next week. Students will be visiting the caravan and learning about resilience.

At the start of last week we welcomed 17 new students to our school, which included 7 new entrants and 10 students throughout the rest of the school. I hope that they are all settling into GPS and have enjoyed the first two weeks here.

Towards the end of last term we started a Newcomers Club for new students in Years 1-6. They will meet fortnightly with Debbie Scott and Deana Averill. This will hopefully be one way to make them feel welcome in our school and get to know other new students who have joined during the year.

If parents need to collect their child/ren during the school day, we ask that you let the school office know an approximate time that you will collect them so that they can wait in the school office for you. For last minute pick-ups, we ask that parents report to the school office and a staff member will collect your child from the classroom or we will phone through.

Our Year 5 and 6 trip to Tekapo was postponed today due to the weather forecast. This will now occur next Friday, 9 August.

With the possibility of snow we have various procedures in place to deal with school closure before the start of the day or during the school day. Our primary concern is always around safety and decisions are based on this. Our school Facebook and Skool Loop App will provide necessary updates. Local radio stations will also provide information if we close before the start of the school day. As staff have to phone parents of bus students if the buses are required to leave early, it is important to understand that all phone lines will be in use. Our initial priority will be to ensure that bus students are away safely. Non bus students will be looked after by staff in designated classes.

Kia kaha, kia toa, kia manawanui – be strong, be bold, be steadfast.
