From the Principal...

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Last Wednesday I had the pleasure of accompanying Tangaroa syndicate on their ski trip to Roundhill. We were fortunate to have perfect conditions, with fresh snowfall the day before improving the experience. Many in the group were giving skiing a go for the first time and I congratulate everyone involved for meeting personal challenges. It was my first time at Roundhill and I was impressed with the varied terrain and how it catered for all abilities.

Many thanks to everyone who returned their decile review surveys. I am pleased to say that we have reached the minimum number of returns required by the Ministry of Education. I will keep you updated regarding the outcome of this process.

Over the past few weeks all classes have been involved in a Keeping Ourselves Safe unit. This has been taught in conjunction with the NZ Police. We have been fortunate to have Senior Constable Maire Froud teaching aspects of this unit, alongside the classroom teachers. They have covered ways for students to keep themselves safe in their interactions with other people and encourage any who need to, to seek help from a trusted adult.

If current or future parents have children who will be starting at GPS in 2021, I ask that they make this known to the school office as soon as possible so that details can be recorded. This will assist us with our planning for next year.

A reminder following the email sent via class teachers this week that the school cross country scheduled for next Monday has been postponed due to Covid Level 2 restrictions. We all look forward to a return to Level 1 so that this event can be rescheduled when it is safe to do so.

Our social worker, Deana Averill and I are holding a coffee morning for interested parents next Tuesday, 15 September from 8.50 - 10am in the school staffroom.
