From the Principal...

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

The announcement this week that most of the country had returned to Covid Level 2, with the Auckland region at Level 3 will have been on the minds of us all. There will be renewed concern for what the immediate future will look like and how any future level change announcements will impact on us.

In the last few days we have seen activities at school being cancelled, or indefinitely postponed, which in turn creates some challenges when planning for the reminder of the term and beyond. I am conscious of my staff, GPS children and their families and what will need to be done in the weeks and months ahead. We have seen the return of contact tracing for all parents and visitors to the school. We have also seen the return of heightened sanitation requirements, together with significant demand for goods and price increases from suppliers. Various Covid-related messages have been posted on the school Facebook page over the last few days. Even if you're not on Facebook, these messages can be accessed on our school website - www.geraldine.school.nz.

Key messages from the most recent posts on Facebook were:

- Classes will continue as normal under L2, with increased hygiene practices in place.
- Students should bring a bottle of water to school, as drinking fountains will be closed.
- Syndicate & whole school assemblies won't be held.
- The school grounds will be closed to students & members of the public from 3.15pm
 8.15am Monday Friday and from 3.15pm Friday to 8.15am Monday.
- At Level 2 parents / whanau will still be able to come on site, but must complete the
 contact tracing register or scan the QR code outside classrooms each time they are
 on site. You only need to do this outside one room if you have more than one child
 at GPS. Please make sure that this is done each time you are on site.
- Parents / caregivers won't be in classrooms at L2. Please say goodbye to your child outside their room if dropping off in the school grounds.
- We respectfully ask that pick up / drop off is done quickly to avoid lingering at either end of the school day. Please vacate the grounds as quickly as possible. Be aware of social distancing requirements
- Pick up / drop off at normal times.

- Any student who is unwell should stay home.
- Students should bring a water bottle to school each day drinking fountains are closed off at Level 2 and above.
- We will continue to keep our school community up to date via Facebook & the Skool Loop app as further information comes to hand.

Please don't underestimate the toll that the Covid experience this year has had on many of us. We all weathered this extraordinary experience over many months, staying positive, being kind and getting through. Any future level change will again see us 'digging deep' to provide for our children and ourselves.

I was so impressed with the staff and the way they all dug deep to support learning during lockdown and Level 3 earlier in the year, as well as tending to their own needs and that of their whanau. This will continue as we enter a new phase. What any response to a level change will be determined and this will be shared with you all in due course.

Be kind to yourself and to others. Please be aware that people will respond differently to the likely challenges that we will again face.

Finally, another reminder that **school will be closed next Thursday**, **20 August** for a day of staff development. This was postpone from earlier in the year. We will be open as usual on Friday, 21 August.

Kia kaha, kia toa, kia manawanui – be strong, be bold, be steadfast.
