#### From the Principal...

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

At our school assembly yesterday, I spoke about the importance of recognising and celebrating diversity and the way it enhances society and how this applies to us at Geraldine Primary School. We are a school made up of a number of different cultures and family backgrounds. A number of our students were born overseas or have strong cultural connections to another country. They may speak a different language in their homes while they are learning and practising English at school. Maintaining their first language is hugely important. Acknowledging and appreciating our cultural diversity ties in with our school values, particularly caring / manaakitanga and respectful / whakaute.

We are approaching the second anniversary of the attacks on the Al Noor and Linwood mosques in Christchurch, which occurred on 15 March 2019. This was a sad day for New Zealand and especially for those who lost family members and friends in the attacks. It is important to recognise that for many their lives will be forever changed due to the events from two years ago. On Monday we will gather briefly as a school to mark this event alongside the 10th anniversary of the Christchurch earthquakes.

Our block of swimming lessons has come to an end over the past two weeks, with Year 4 - 6 students having four weeks at the Community Pool and Year 1 - 3 five weeks at our school pool. A big thank you to our Home and School for again funding the swimming lessons, our tutors from CBay and local tutors Jo Cummings and Adrienne Ross. It has been pleasing to note the progress that students have made over this time, largely due to the frequency of the tuition. For the older students, the culmination of their lessons was the swimming sports, which we managed to have at the third try on Tuesday. In this event, students were able to push themselves, compete at their level and achieve goals. Many thanks to everyone who came along to support the event and their child(ren).

Today we have six students: Charlotte and Sam, Year 5; Sam, Elin, Grace and William, Year 6, representing GPS at the South Canterbury Schools' Triathlon. We wish them all the best for this event and look forward to hearing how they get on.
