From the Principal...

Kia ora Whānau.

Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Welcome back to term 4 everyone! I hope all GPS families had an enjoyable term break. The term ahead is a short one - just over 8 weeks long, so time will go by quickly I suspect. As always, there is much to do and look forward to in Term 4.

This week our Year 5 and 6 classes have visited Peel Forest to take part in bush walks and learn about the environment in that area. The day was run by trainee outdoor education instructors from Ara, as part of their coursework. By all accounts, it was a wonderful experience for our students and we are grateful to Ara for allowing us to work with their instructors. Many thanks to all the parents who provided transport and supervision on the day - much appreciated!

Inter school basketball has restarted this week and we have three teams competing in Timaru each Monday (Year 4) and Tuesday (Year 5 and 6) nights. While the initial organisation has been done by school, we are grateful to the parents who have stepped in as coaches and managers to enable our teams to participate in this competition. We hope to be able to update you with some results as they come in.

Over the holidays the senior toilets have been upgraded and are looking much better than what was in place previously! This project was funded by the School Board, who are committed to ensuring that our students have up to date and modern facilities throughout the school. For the time being, our

building work is complete, but next year we will consider the next steps for further property modernisation.

The current Covid alert levels are providing additional challenges to schools. We are receiving regular updates and guidance from the Ministry of Education and we respond to these as relevant to our situation at Level 2. At GPS we are planning for Term 4 events and how these can still occur at Level 2 as well as normal operations should we move to Level 1. Events at Level 2 will mean that there will be amendments to what we would normally do. We will keep you updated as to what these changes are. Our inaugural Year 5 and 6 sports exchange with Methven Primary has been cancelled due to the current situation.

We are planning an alternative to our athletic sports that was scheduled for 10 November should we still be at Level 2. Classes are currently practising the different skills as part of their PE sessions. If we are at Level 2, the measurement of heights / distances etc will occur during class time, i.e. no normal athletics day event will take place at Level 2. From here, we will be able to gauge placings in each age group. If we are at Level 1 on 10 November, we will continue our normal athletics event and for this, we will be requiring parent helpers to assist with the various events. If you are able to assist at Level 1, please contact your child's teacher.

As signalled previously, Level 2 does require parents / whānau on school premises to wear a face mask, that drop off and pick up is done promptly in an outdoor environment (i.e. not in classrooms) and only being on site if necessary. Social distancing also needs to be observed. Parents / whānau can collect their children from 2:30pm, to avoid congestion around the gates at 2:45pm. We do appreciate the support that we have had to date from parents thus far in this regard.

There has been a lot of information in the media about vaccinations and what is required and by when. A legislated Health Order is expected to come out very soon, which will provide further guidance for schools around vaccination requirements.

We will soon begin the process of forming classes for 2022. If you have a 5 year old New Entrant child who will start with us next, year, or know of someone who this applies to, it is important that the office is informed as soon as possible and an enrolment form completed, if this hasn't been done already. This also applies to children in other year groups who will be attending GPS from 2021. Having an accurate understanding about new enrolments is important as it assists within the composition of classes.

As part of the class formation process, if parents have any factors that they would like senior staff to consider regarding their child(ren), please put these in writing to me by way of a letter or email – principal@geraldine.school.nz as

soon as possible or by Monday 15 November at the latest. Whilst we will take these factors into consideration, we are unable to guarantee each request. Please note that this is not an opportunity to request a particular teacher or being placed with particular friends. If you know now that your child is not going to be attending GPS in 2022 (other than Year 6's), please let me know in writing as soon as possible.

We are currently undergoing a review of our school curriculum. Part of this involves surveying our parents about various aspects of what our local curriculum could look like in the future. A survey link will be emailed out to parents tonight and we would really appreciate it if you could take 10 minutes to complete the survey. We ask that this is done by Monday 1 November please. Cox Street Crossing Yellow no parking lines
