From the Principal...

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Geraldine Primary is a busy place at the moment with a number of events having been recently held or not too far away. Tangaroa (Year 5 and 6) held their triathlon last week and Tāwhirimātea (Year 3 and 4) will hold theirs at school next week. Our Year 4 - 6 swimming sports were postponed yesterday, so we are hoping for fine weather on Monday. Year 6 classes head off to Lindisfarne for their annual camp next Tuesday and the Year 5 classes will be going to Raincliffe in three weeks time. Tāwhirimātea are also working with staff from ECan and Fish and Game to support the work that is happening in classes.

All these activities require significant planning by staff and a lot of assistance from parents / whanau to ensure they can take place, are safe and successful. Many thanks to everyone involved who make them happen, in order to provide varied experiences for our children.

This area will look significantly different once it's completed and will provide a wonderful space for the Room 3 students as well as additional areas for staff and students to work in.
