From the Principal...

Kia ora Whanau. Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Welcome everyone to the start of the 2021 school year. I trust that the summer break has gone well and that you all found the time to relax and enjoy a change of pace after what was an interesting and somewhat disrupted 2020!

On Monday we welcomed 19 new students and their whanau to our school with our traditional start of year powhiri. It's always exciting to welcome new families to our school and together with the staff, we look forward to building a connection with them over their time at GPS. A huge thank you to Elizabeth Murray and ex GPS student (now Year 7) Mya Henry for performing the karanga, to Gideon Snow for representing and speaking on behalf of the new students and whanau and to Addie Couch-Snow who again supported the powhiri and new whanau. It's great to start our year with a powhiri and for everyone to be together once again.

Classes have started swimming tuition, with Year 1 - 3 at school and Year 4 - 6 at the Community Pool. We are again grateful to the Home and School group for their support of swimming by paying for tutors and venue hire and know that our tamariki (children) get so much from the weeks of swimming.

GPS has a uniform that is distinctive and one that looks great when worn well. Please ensure that your child is wearing this correctly, as per our uniform requirements. Towards the end of 2020 and so far this year we have a small number of students / families applying their own variations to the uniform. Plain navy sun hats are to be worn in Terms 1 and 4. Shorts, trackpants, culottes and if worn, long sleeve thermal tops, need to be navy, not black or another colour. Please refer to our uniform expectations, which have been included with this newsletter. I thank you for your support in this matter.

Our next building project is due to start in just over a week after the planning stages, which ran through last year. The area that will be redeveloped is Room 3 and the adjacent spaces. The existing toilets will be remodelled into work, break out and storage areas. In time, Room 3 students will use the toilets at the other end of the senior block, which has been earmarked for future development. The work area around Room 3 will be fenced

off but the library will still be accessible for use. It is anticipated that the project will be completed by early - mid June.

School notices:

Uniform expectations

- Apple green polo shirt
- Navy blue sunhat plain
- Polar fleece / Merino half zip jersey with GPS logo. Must be embroidered prior to being worn at school.
- Track pants can either be sports type track pants, which may have a small logo, or fleecy. Must be in navy, not black or denim.
- Shorts / Culottes / Skort navy. Shorts can be sports brand type, cotton or fleecy. No checked pattern or denim.
- Tights, Leggings & Thermals optional. Must be plain navy. These will typically be worn in winter terms or on colder days late Term 1 / early Term 4. No stripes / other colours.
- Socks plain white, black or navy short sports-type socks. Shoe or low calf length. Girls may wear navy knee highs or tights.
- Shoes sports shoes or black school shoes all year. Sports sandals may be worn in Terms 1 and 4.
- Jackets optional, may be worn to and from school and in the playground if it is cold. They are to be removed in class.

Not part of the school uniform, but suitable for mufti days:

Brightly coloured socks, jeans, riding boots, sports club uniforms / gear, striped thermals, general mufti
