From the Principal...

Kia ora Whānau.

Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Since the start of term all classes have been involved in **swimming lessons**, with Years 1 - 3 being taught at school by our staff and Years 4 - 6 at the Community Pool by swim tutors. Again this year the cost of tutors and pool hire has been generously funded by our Home and School group, for which we are very grateful. Teachers have reported some pleasing levels of progress within the lessons. Year 4 - 6 classes are doing a two day swimming carnival (one for widths, one for lengths) and Years 1 - 3 have had a Water Skills for Life programme as part of their lessons.

Followers of our school Facebook page and Skool Loop app will have received an update about the **Covid Phase 3 announcement** yesterday afternoon. Through the Ministry of Education, schools were informed that the country moved into Phase 3 of the response to Omicron from 11:59pm yesterday, Thursday 24 February. In Phase 3, only household contacts of confirmed cases are required to self-isolate. All positive cases will need to isolate at home for 10 days, as will everyone else in the household. All other contacts of Covid-positive people are not required to isolate, but they will need to closely monitor for any developing symptoms and stay at home if these escalate. While this is a significant change from previous responses, we remain confident that we have the necessary systems in place at school to minimise any spread across year groups.

We remind all staff, students, parents and caregivers to monitor for symptoms at all times. If your child is sick with Covid-like symptoms, please keep them away from school and get a Covid test. They can return to school with a negative test. If a parent / caregiver / child tests positive, please inform the school immediately - 693 8208 between 8:15am and 3:15pm, or email the Principal - Andrew Leverton: principal@geraldine.school.nz outside of these office hours.

If you are unsure about how to respond to this changing situation, please get in touch with me.

Our **3 Way Conferences** are scheduled for 24 March from 3pm - 6pm and on 25 March from 12.45pm - 5.30pm. Classes will end at 12.15pm on 25 March and buses will depart at this time. The booking website is now live and you can book your 3 Way Conference at www.schoolinterviews.co.nz. The code is 94cds. Currently face to face 3WCs remains our preference, but we will continue to monitor the evolving Omicron situation and keep you updated. Adults and children in Years 4 - 6 will need to wear masks at the 3WCs. If this is not suitable, staff can arrange a 3WC by Zoom. You will still need to book your slot online and then email your child's teacher with your time and request a Zoom. Please contact the office if you are not able to book online.

Over the next one to two weeks we have our Year 5 and 6 classes attending **camps at Raincliff and Lindisfarne** respectively. These are currently proceeding and we will continue to monitor the Omicron situation and how it relates to us and these camps.

We currently have a vacancy on the **School Board**. The Board of elected parents oversees the governance and strategic direction of the school, along with myself as Principal and our staff-elected representative Jo Drake. The Board has elected to fill this vacancy by selection. If more than 10% of the school's eligible voter roll (parents) wish for a bi election to be held, the relevant procedures will then occur. The deadline for this request is 3pm Friday 25 March (28 days after this notice). Requests must be put in writing to the school office by post, in person or by email - office@geraldine.school.nz.
