From the Principal...

Kia ora Whānau.

Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

This week marks the halfway point of the term and like any other, it has gone by reasonably quickly. While our Covid cases are currently very few, we, like other schools, have been quite heavily impacted by student absence, most of which is due to sickness. We appreciate the support of our school whānau in keeping children home if they are unwell, or collecting them during the day if they become unwell. The staff and I understand that parents' work can be affected when their children are at home sick.

Alongside this, we have seen an increase in absences that are explained but unjustified or where no reason is given. The reasons for such absences can be many and varied. Irregular attendance can have an impact on the continuity in student learning and gaps can then start to appear. Attendance at school is a nationwide issue and has been since 2015. Covid has further impacted on this in the last two years. This week the Ministry of Education has launched a resource to highlight the importance of regular attendance at school, with a section specifically for parents and whānau - https://temahau.govt.nz/tips-for-parents-and-whanau. If you are concerned about your child's attendance, and would like some further support, please feel free to contact either myself or your child's teacher.

Each term we review certain policies on a three-year cycle. Parents are invited to be part of the review process. The policies that are for review this term are student and staff wellbeing and safety. We have appointed Sheree Carter to cover Anna's position while she is away and congratulate Sheree on her appointment. We look forward to welcoming her to the GPS staff soon.
