From the Principal...

Kia ora Whānau.

Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all.

Welcome back to the start of Term 3 everyone! I hope you have all had a safe and enjoyable term break. It was wonderful to see our tamariki back at school on Monday. It has been quite an eventful week, largely due to circumstances beyond our control. The flooding experienced in the middle of the week was possibly expected. This saw the cancellation of buses on Wednesday, but we were fortunate in that we were able to stay open for learning. Some staff had to make detours on their way to school to find roads that were accessible.

The bomb threats that a small number of schools throughout New Zealand received during the week, but particularly yesterday, was certainly unexpected.

We have a series of procedures that guide us if we need to evacuate children and staff from buildings and conversely if we need to keep children and staff inside buildings (i.e. lockdown). These are available through our School Docs portal. In this instance if you search under Emergency Management you will be taken to a range of procedures on how such emergencies are handled. We regularly review, revisit these and practice drills at school with the staff and children.

It is important to note that if we are under Police instruction, e.g. for a bomb threat, or lockdown, parents and the school will need to follow Police requirements. At all times, the staff will have the safety of our students as their priority, and for some, this is over the safety of their own children who may attend other schools.

Earlier in the week I emailed parents about the need to retake class photos. The new day for this is Tuesday 9 August. Any new sibling photos will be taken in the hall from 8:30am. These will be due to new siblings starting at school or if this opportunity was missed last term. Please let the office know by Friday 5 August if this applies to you. Once the sibling photos have been taken, we will move through the classes, typically juniors first, then middles and seniors.

There is a note below regarding this term's 3 Way Conferences. These are scheduled for 17 and 18 August. Please note that classes will stop at 12:30pm on the 18th, to allow for a 1pm start for the 3WCs. Buses will leave shortly after 12:30pm and will only have GPS students on them. If your child is on the bus, please be at the bus stop to collect them. All other students will leave the school at 12:30pm to bike / walk home, or to be collected. If they are departing school independently, please be at home to meet them.

Lastly, a reminder that nominations for the School Board close on Wednesday 3 August at 12 noon. Details were emailed out to all parents during the holidays.
